Work experience of a **non-clinical** nature will be for a maximum period of one week and will take place in a general non-clinical, corporate setting such as Human Resources, IT, Finance, Communications and Marketing, and are mainly based at our head office in the Birmingham City Centre. Non-clinical Tasks would include for example: answering the phone; assisting with filing/data input/photocopying/creating flyers; arranging and attending meetings; minute taking; research; shadowing reception staff.

Clinical Work Experience

Clinical work experience is undertaken in a multi-disciplinary setting and provides students the opportunity to gain a holistic insight by talking to/shadowing a range of professionals and experience first-hand how the team interacts. Clinical work experience supports staff duties and reflects the role of a Health Care Assistant.

Tasks may include: assisting with bed making; shadowing a nurse or healthcare support worker; assisting with meals; talking to service users (with their express permission); assisting with activities; helping/shadowing professionals in clinics; observing ward rounds etc. However, the Work Experience **will not** offer a Psychology focus or involve any kind of counselling or shadowing the actual treatment of patients. These opportunities are for a one-off period of up to a maximum of two weeks.
