Description of indicator	To capture qualitative data and information about Severe and Enduring Eating Disorder (SEED) patients that evidence indicators for early detection of this specific cohort. Whilst building upon the systematic collection of outcome measures of patients receiving inpatient care at admission and discharge during 14/15.

Rationale for inclusion	<p>Patients with severe and enduring eating disorders are extremely difficult to treat and have developed anorexia as adolescents. Patients have suffered from severe anorexia for at least seven years, with an average duration of illness of more than 15 years.</p> <p>Anorexia nervosa has the highest mortality rate of any psychiatric disorder. Most individuals with SEED have been through multiple inpatient treatment episodes. They have low motivation and a self-image dominated by illness.</p> <p>After prolonged malnourishment, many of those with SEED are disabled and unable to work. They often suffer from neurocognitive, cardiac or liver problems, as well as osteoporosis.</p> <p>To enable clinicians and the CRG to develop treatment models for use with this highly complex group of patients whether as inpatient or within the community.</p>
