Those who die during their in-patient stay.  
Where legal precedence has forced removal of the patient from the country.  
Patients transferred to the in-patient care of another NHS mental health organisation.

Using the discharge destination from the following list:

Scottish High Security Psychiatric hospital  
NHS High Secure Psychiatric hospital  
NHS medium secure unit  
NHS ward for mental illness or LD CAMHS Wards.

**Local exclusion criteria**

Patients admitted to provide overnight sleep tests and are not in receipt of psychiatric care.  
Patients discharged and leave the country within 7 days of discharge.  
Patients who are discharged to non NHS psychiatric Hospitals.
