Patient transport to out of area facilities is provided by Secure Care UK and Prometheus.

Please also note that non -urgent patient transport is provided either in house by the Trust's transport fleet or via the contract we have with local taxi firm.

2. When did this contract to provide secure, mental health transport commence?

Secure Care UK contract start date - 4/9/2017

Prometheus contract start date - 20/06/2016

Local Taxi Firm contract start date - Contract expired

3. When is this contract to provide secure, non-emergency mental health patient transport due to expire?

Secure Care UK contract end date 31st March 2022

Prometheus contract ad hoc upon formal termination of this agreement dated 20/06/2016

Local Taxi Firm contract end date – New service level agreement being negotiated with anticipated expiry of March 2023.

Secure Care UK – Contract was let as initial period of 12 months with option to extend 3 x 12 months .
