Consultants are paid according to the nationally agreed TCS. Midpoint of pay scale is £406 per day (8 hours)

Night shift

Consultants do not work night shifts. In accordance with the TCS, they are paid an availability supplement according to the frequency of the non-resident on call rota. For a 1:9 or less frequent rota, the supplement is 3% of their basic salary

2. When junior doctors are not on strike, how much is the average junior doctor at your trust paid for the following:

Day shift

In accordance with nationally agreed TCS there are 5 different pay points for 5 different junior doctor grades.

The basic salary for FY1 is £113 per day, FY2 is £130 per day, CT1/CT2 is £154 per day, CT3/ST4/ST5 is £195 per day, ST6/ST7 is £224 per day.

Night shift

Junior Doctors are paid a variety of pay supplements for out of hours work. Supplements range from £8,593 to £12,891 per annum depending on whether the junior doctor is FY2, CT1, CT2 or CT3.
