## \*\*Clarification\*\*:

- Community based service for adult clients are defined as Secondary Care Services (ICCR including Bipolar and Eating Disorder Services) and the Primary Care IAPT Service where the person is over 18 years at referral

- Community based service for children and young people are restricted to those referred into the Trust's CAMHS Service

- Birmingham and Solihull Mental Health NHS Foundation Trust, Barnardo's and Autism West Midlands work together to provide emotional wellbeing and mental health services for children and young people in Solihull within our Child and Adolescent Mental Health Service (Solar).

We provide multi-disciplinary assessment and treatment of children and young people with mental health or severe emotional and behavioural difficulties. The service currently accepts children and young people, until their 19th birthday, who are residents in the borough of Solihull, go to school or college in the Solihull area, or have a Solihull GP.

For information on children and young people in receipt of CAMHS services in Birmingham, please redirect your request to Forward Thinking Birmingham Service which is hosted by Birmingham Women's and Children's Trust.

- Count of unique Service Spells per month of within which the Referral was received, not each year they were open to the Service or the year first seen occurred

- Help determined as either an assessment having happened or discharged without an assessment wherein they were discharged elsewhere for support or with advice

- There is a nationally funded programme of work to support transformation of community mental health services across the country and is also being implemented within Birmingham and Solihull. As part of this there is an aim to reduce waiting times with a national proposed standard of 4 weeks to initial access. However, the detailed national guidance and timelines have yet to be confirmed.
