Background Information: Birmingham and Solihull Mental Health NHS Foundation Trust provide a low secure inpatient Child and Adolescent Mental Health Service (CAMHS) and a medium secure inpatient Forensic Child and Adolescent Mental Health Service (FCAMHS).

The low secure inpatient Child and Adolescent Mental Health service (CAMHS) provides multidisciplinary assessments, mental health intervention and treatment for patients with mental health difficulties, until their 18th birthday.

The medium secure inpatient Forensic Child and Adolescent Mental Health Service (FCAMHS) provides multi-disciplinary assessments, mental health intervention and treatment for patients with forensic history and complex mental health difficulties, until their 19th birthday.

Both services are nationally commissioned and available to patients across England

Please note, that the Trust do not place patients nor spend with other providers in the provision of a tier 4 CAMHS service.
