

Data Quality Tools

Introduction

Data Quality Tools which can be accessed at DQTools [http://iis-app-01/DQTools] is the replacement for **RiO** of **CSDTools** the data quality management system for **ePEX**. **Data Quality Tools** consists of *aspx* pages with an underlying SQL Server 2008 database. Access permissions are controlled at the admin page DQTools/Admin [http://iis-app-01/DQTools/admin.aspx]

Functionality

The tool allows comparison of demographic data from RiO with demographic data from the national SCR system. The following data comparisons are available from the *Admin* tab:

- patients with a discrepancy for both address and GP practice
- patients with a date of death [http://is-wiki-01/dokuwiki/doku.php?id=rio:deceased_patients_and_dqtools] on the SCR not matched on RiO
- patients where the national system is unable to trace or confirm an NHS number
- patients with a discrepancy for GP practice only
- patients with a discrepancy for address only

With some modification, the tool could be used to audit other things such as the percentage of a cohort of records to have validated NHS numbers.

Auditing Records

Records with a discrepancy on the criteria(s) chosen can be viewed from the tab *Pending Issues* in *DQ Issues* and audited. After comparing the record on RiO and the SCR, RiO is updated, if and as appropriate, and an audit is made. There are a number of possible options but the main choices are:

- Accept National where the National System is right and RiO is updated
- Accept Local where the National System is wrong and RiO is unchanged
- Investigate for records which present difficulties which cannot be immediately resolved.

Free text comments such as Already Updated can be added if this is appropriate.

After updating the Audit screen and returning to the list, the audited record will have been removed from Pending Issues.
