- 3. Please provide the number of individual orthopaedic surgeons actively performing procedures at your Trust.
- 4. Please provide a list of job titles of those clinicians involved in decision making for the procurement or evaluation of orthopaedic medical devices.
- 5. Please provide the name of any current procurement frameworks or contracts used for orthopaedic implants and devices.
- 6. Please confirm whether your Trust uses a standardised formulary or approved supplier list for orthopaedic devices. If so, please provide a copy or summary.
- 7. Please provide an estimated average spend per procedure for the below: (if you have them)
 - Ankle Replacement
 - Ankle Arthroscopy
 - Revision Surgery
 - Anatomic Total Shoulder Replacement
 - Reverse Total Shoulder Replacement
